UNSCR 1540 (2004)




- Adopted on 28 April 2004
- Establishes **legally binding obligations** on all UN Member States
- All States shall implement measures aimed at preventing **non-State actors** from acquiring WMDs, related materials, and their means of delivery.

Republic Act 10697

Strategic Trade Management Act (STMA)

“An act preventing the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction by managing the trade in strategic goods, the provision of related services, and for other purposes”

The Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and the National Strategic Goods List (NSGL) were published in 25 September 2018 in the Official Gazette.



National Security Council- Strategic Trade Management Committee (NSC-STMCom)



A permanent committee under the National Security Council (NSC) acting as the **central authority** on all matters of strategic trade management.

Strategic Trade Management Office (STMO)

The lead government agency responsible for managing the trade of strategic goods and technologies to prevent the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction.



Organizational Structure



Partners with industries to promote awareness and compliance

Handles technical and end-use/end-user risk assessments on issuing authorization

Enforces the STMA, conducts audits, determines violations


CATCH-ALL CONTROLS



Military Goods

Items, software and technology that are specifically designed, developed, configured, adapted, or modified for **military end use**.





Dual-Use Goods

Items, software and technology, which can be used for **both civil and military end use** or in connection with the development, production, handling, operation, maintenance, storage, detection, identification or dissemination of weapons of mass destruction or their means of delivery.



WMD/Military Use

AD's or ADS's convert analog signals changing over time into streams of numerical data which can be analyzed by computers



Missiles

High-speed data conversion



Nationally-Controlled Goods

Goods placed under unilateral controls for reasons of **national security, foreign policy, anti-terrorism, crime control and public safety**.



Catch-all Provision

Goods or services are or may be used, partly or entirely in the acquisition, development, et. al. of WMDs.

Country of destination is subject to an international sanction or an arms embargo and goods can be used for military end-use.

An authorization for unlisted goods is necessary in the following instances:

Goods may be used as parts or components of military items listed in the NSGL that have been exported without a license.

Exporter knows or suspects that the unlisted goods may be used for any of the uses referred to in para. (a) and (b).


Export

Actual shipment of strategic goods **out of the Philippines.**



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Transmission of software and technology either in electronic/ non-electronic form.



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ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES



Warning/ Orders for Corrective Action



Limitation/ revocation/ annulment of authorization/ registration



Fines



Cancellation/ suspension of authority to operate with SEC/ DTI

CRIMINAL PENALTIES



Imprisonment for a period of **six (6) years and one (1) day to twelve (12) years**, and a fine from one million pesos (P1,000,000.00) to five million pesos (P5,000,000.00)




Imprisonment for a period of **six (6) months and one (1) day to six (6) years**, and a fine from one hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) to one million pesos (P1,000,000.00)
