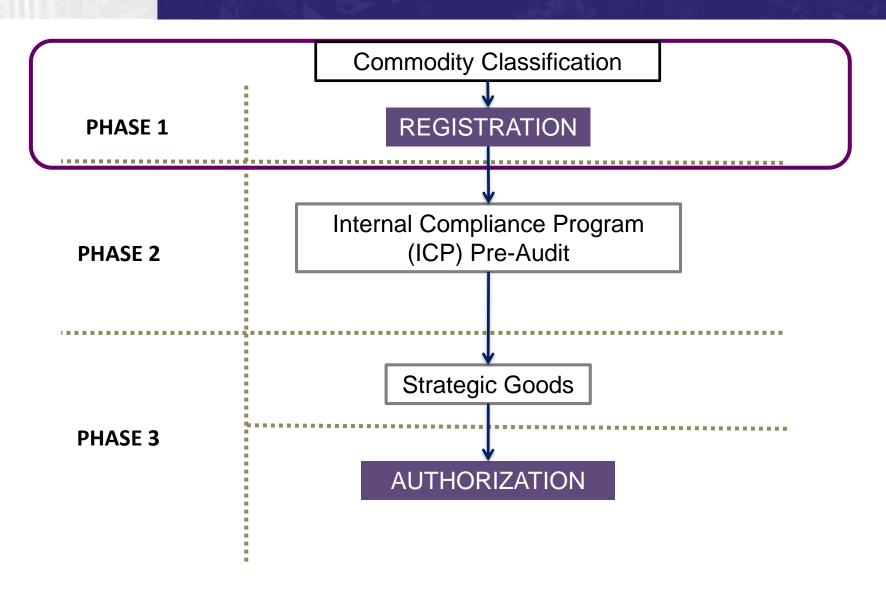

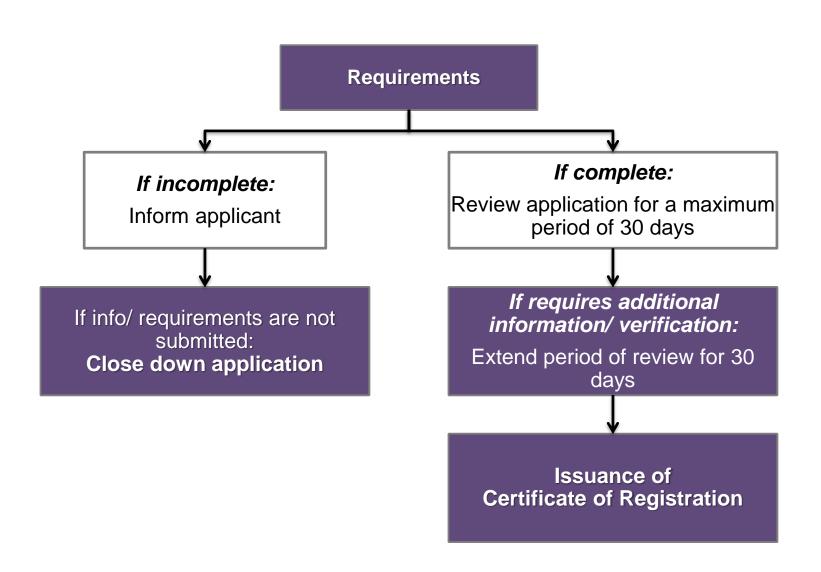

National Security related civil or criminal proceedings have commenced against the applicant



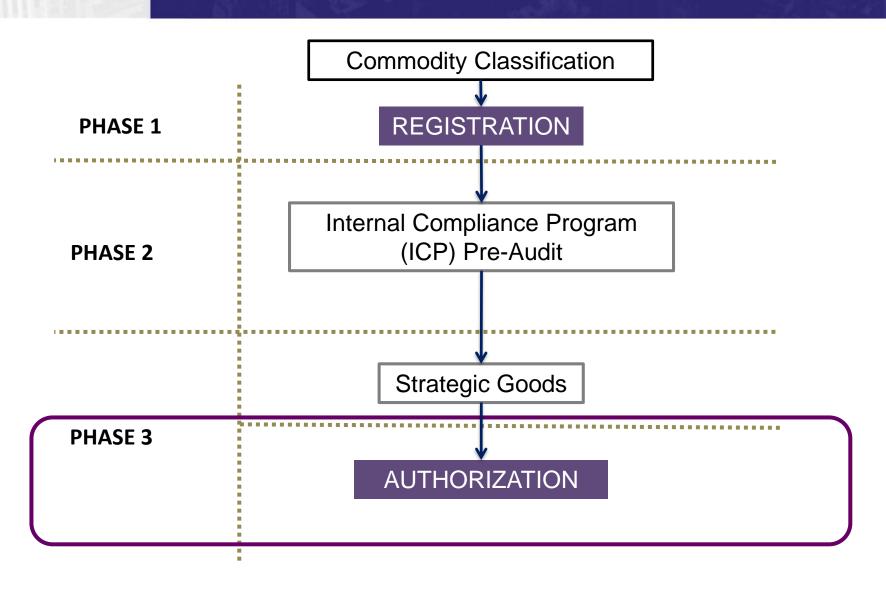
Violation of a international embargo or sanction binding on the Philippines



Any other national security concerns that may exist

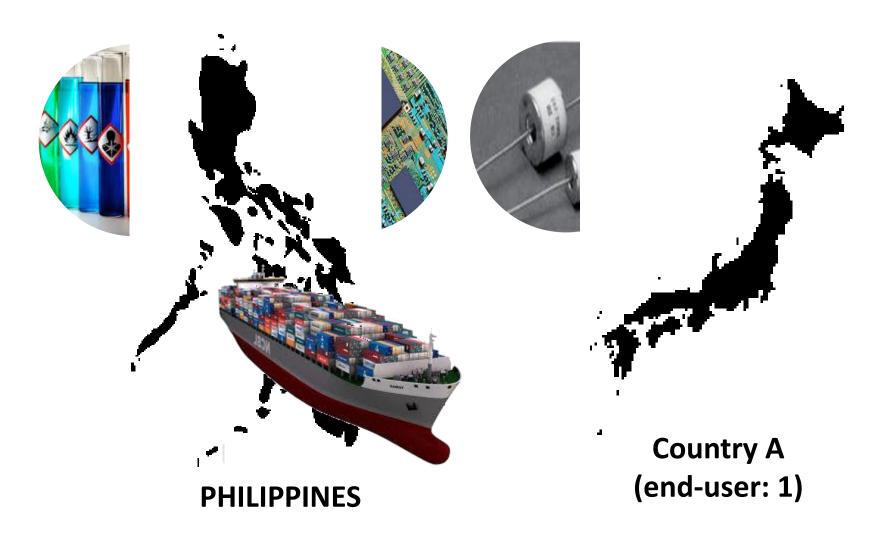

RISK ASSESSMENT CRITERIA



Terrorism or organized criminal activities



Preservation of regional peace, security and stability



International tensions or armed conflict in the destination country



Human rights and international humanitarian law



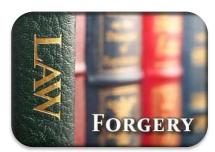
Commitments under UNSC sanctions, relevant international treaties and non-proliferation agreements



Security interests of a country which is an ally to the Philippines



Technical capacity of the recipient country



Submission of false documents, made misleading information and concealed material facts



RISK ASSESSMENT CRITERIA



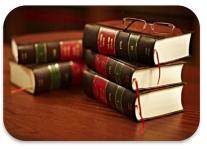
Risk of illegal end-use or by a restricted party



Risk of diversion to an unauthorized end-user or end-use



Criminal or civil proceedings related to national security have commenced against the applicant



Violations of STMA and its IRR



Goods are under a police investigation or court proceedings



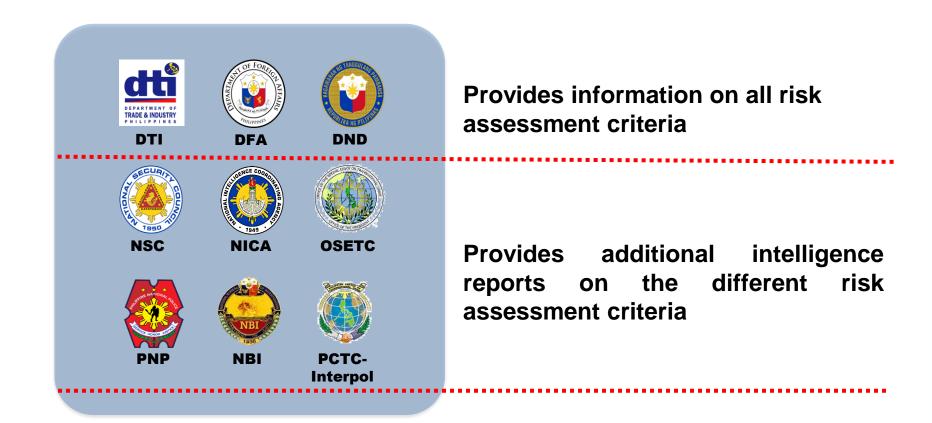
Violation of an international embargo or sanction binding on the Philippines



Other national security or foreign policy reasons



RISK ASSESSMENT





Risk Assessment

Customer/ Purchasing agent:

- Reluctant to offer information or evasive about the end-use of the item
- Willing to pay cash for a very expensive item
- Little to no business background
- Unfamiliar with the product's performance characteristics but still wants the product
- Unclear about whether the purchased product is for domestic use, for export, or for reexport
- Routine installation, training, or maintenance services are declined by the customer



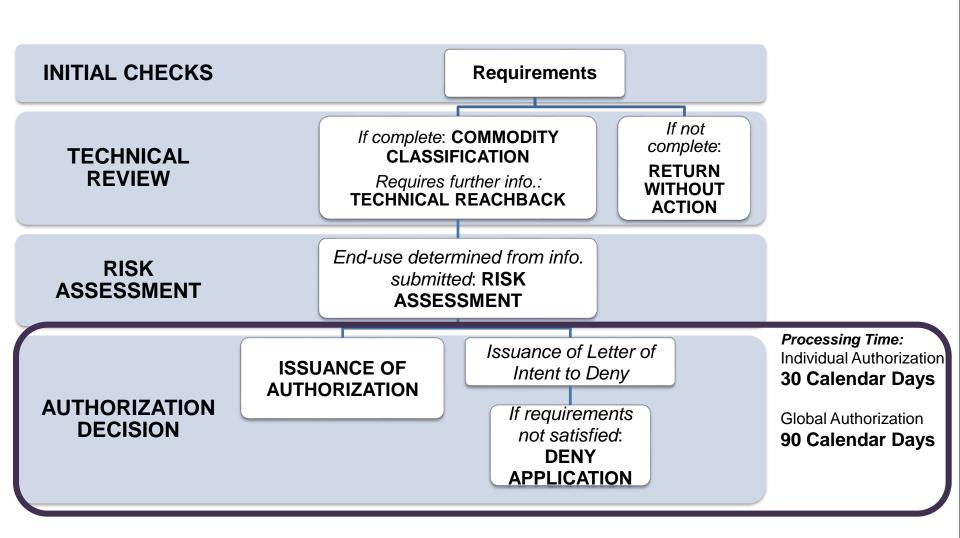
Risk Assessment

Product

- Capabilities do not fit the buyer's line of business
- A freight forwarding firm is listed as the product's final destination
- The shipping route is abnormal for the product and destination
- Unusual shipping, packaging, or labelling arrangements are requested
- Unusual requirements for excessive confidentiality about final destinations, or customers, or specifications of items
